

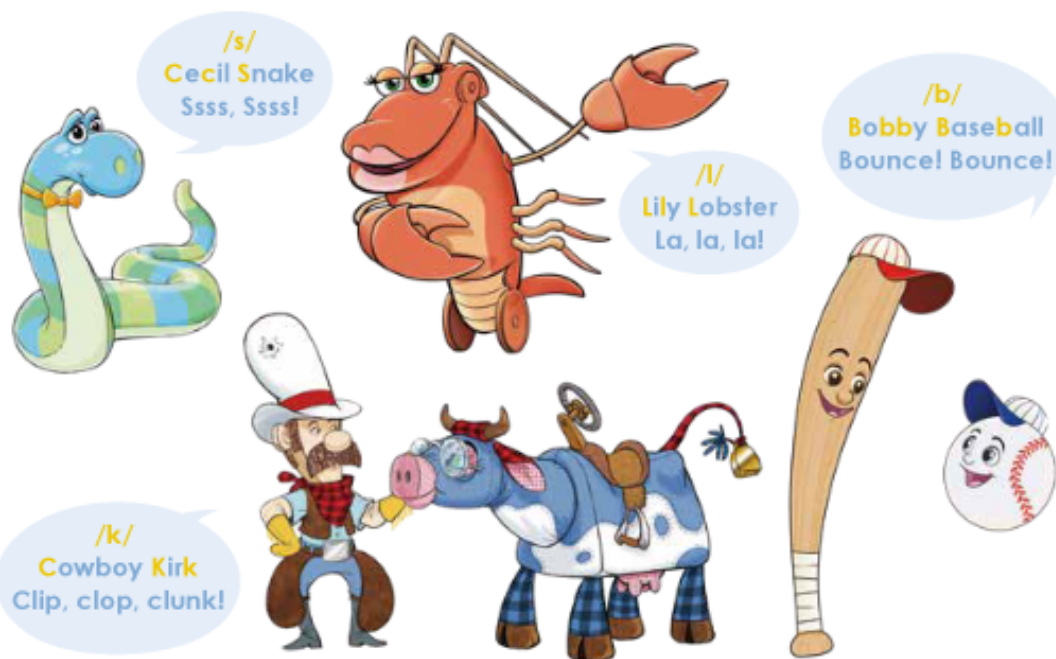

Using colorful posters, children experience language by listening, moving, and singing. While singing, they practice pronunciation as they learn English greetings and vocabulary. A musical environment is a joyful place.

While students participate in class, they also learn hand motions and movement. These motions, or finger plays, not only help children learn language, they sharpen their memory through imitation and repetition. For example, while singing Lily Lobster, the students will pinch their fingers together like lobster claws. Singing and doing finger plays are social activities that are encouraging and motivating to young children. Through shared music, your child experiences joy as they learn English.
