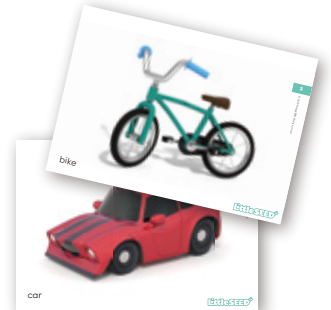

At the end of the lessons, teachers review the words as they put them back in the box. This is a fun, exciting way to expose children to new words.
